Monthly Options for Families

All monthly plans provide intensive 1-on-1 behavior therapy which includes natural environment teaching, treatment plans, progress summaries, assessments at regular intervals, skill acquisition and behavior tracking, as well as parent and family training.

Premium

- ◆ 25 hours per week (100 hours/month) of 1-on-1 behavior therapy

Enhanced

- ◆ 15 hours per week (60 hours/month) of 1-on-1 behavior therapy

Basic

- ◆ 10 hours per week (40 hours/month) of 1-on-1 behavior therapy



All monthly plans require at least a three-month commitment after an initial two week trial period. Please inquire about six month and yearly options.

Initial Assessment (ABLLS)

For children that do not have a current Assessment of Basic Learning and Language Skills (ABLLS), the Initial Assessment includes comprehensive testing, direct observation, and parent reporting. ABLLS are important because they provide a good starting point to understand where a child is developmentally and, additionally; with ABLLS you can track skill progress to fine-tune individualized treatment plans.

- ◆ One-time assessment fees
- ◆ Monthly and hourly plans include updates to this assessment at no additional charge after the first assessment
- ◆ Children with existing ABLLS do not require the initial assessment
